- Latin Name: *Euphrasia officinalis*
- Alternative Names: Euphrasia, Eye-bright
- Plant Family: Orobanchaceae (formerly Scrophulariaceae)
- Parts Used: Aerial parts (flowering tops)
- Origin: Native to Europe; found in meadows and grasslands

Traditionally used for everything from hay fever to conjunctivitis, its gentle astringency and anti-inflammatory action make it ideal for irritated eyes and upper respiratory challenges. ## Supports Eye Clarity and Conjunctival Health

Eyebright is best known for its affinity with the eyes. Used in eyewashes or compresses, it soothes redness, irritation, and mild infections like conjunctivitis. Its gentle astringent and anti-inflammatory actions tighten and tone the delicate tissues around the eyes, relieving puffiness and brightening the gaze.

## Relieves Hay Fever and Seasonal Allergies

With its drying and cooling energetics, Eyebright eases symptoms of allergic rhinitis, such as watery eyes, runny nose, sneezing, and itchiness. It works well in combination with Elderflower and Nettle Leaf to address the overactive histamine response and support mucosal calm.

## Tones and Protects Mucous Membranes

Eyebright's astringent action makes it helpful for inflamed, weepy mucous membranes throughout the respiratory and digestive tract. It gently tightens lax tissues while reducing excess discharge—ideal for post-nasal drip, sinus infections, and loose stools.

## Supports Cognitive and Nervous System Alertness

As its Latin name *Euphrasia* (from the Greek 'cheerfulness') suggests, Eyebright has long been used to promote mental clarity and wakefulness. It uplifts foggy, heavy states of mind and has a subtle nervine quality that sharpens perception without overstimulation.

## Reduces Eye Strain from Screens and Fatigue

In today's digital age, Eyebright offers gentle support for tired, strained eyes. A tea or compress after long screen use can refresh the gaze, soothe soreness, and restore tone. Its long tradition of use by scribes and scholars speaks to its support for visual concentration and reading endurance.

## Folklore & History

In European folk medicine, Eyebright was considered a sacred herb for 'second sight' and insight. Its name and flower markings gave rise to the Doctrine of Signatures, where appearance reflects purpose. Monks and herbalists in the Middle Ages used it to treat eye conditions and brighten the spirit. It was often made into tinctures or infused into lotions and poultices for topical application.

## Traditional Usage

Eyebright is typically used as a tea, tincture, or eye compress. It is also used in homeopathic preparations for allergic or inflammatory eye complaints. Pairs beautifully with Elderflower, Chamomile, or Goldenrod in allergy blends. Externally, it is infused into sterile eye washes or cold compresses for tired or infected eyes.

## Herbal Actions

Astringent, Anti-inflammatory, Anticatarrhal, Mild nervine, Antihistamine, Tonic to mucous membranes

## Energetics & Tissue States

Temperature: Cooling

Moisture: Drying

Tissue States: Damp, Relaxed, Lax, Inflamed

## Active Compounds

- Iridoid glycosides – Anti-inflammatory and mucosal support
- Tannins – Astringent and toning
- Flavonoids – Antioxidant and antihistamine
- Volatile oils – Mild antimicrobial effects

## **Dosage & Preparation**

- Tea: 1–2 tsp dried herb per cup, steep 10–15 mins; up to 3x daily
- Tincture: 1–3 ml up to 3x daily
- Eye Compress: Infused tea on sterile cotton, cool before use
- Eye Wash: Use cooled infusion with sterile saline (under guidance)

## **Safety & Contraindications**

- Generally very safe for internal use
- Ensure absolute sterility when using as eye wash
- Avoid if eyes are severely infected or require medical attention
- External use should be short-term and well-strained to avoid irritation

## **Herbal Pairings**

- Elderflower – for allergies and mucosal tone
- Nettle Leaf – for antihistamine support
- Chamomile – to calm inflammation and soothe the nervous system
- Goldenrod – for sinus support and catarrh
- Plantain – for mucosal repair and astringency
