Dosage & Preparation

- Tea: 1–2 tsp dried leaf per cup, steep 5–10 mins; enjoy up to 3x daily
- Tincture: 2–4 ml up to 3x daily
- Bath: Add a handful of dried leaf or 3–5 drops of essential oil
- Culinary: Used in herbal vinegars, desserts, or lemony herbal teas

Safety & Contraindications

- Generally safe in appropriate amounts
- Rare cases of gastric irritation with high doses
- Avoid high intake during pregnancy without practitioner supervision
- Monitor with known allergies to citrus oils

Herbal Pairings
